

California Prop 65 Certification of Conformance

Proposition 65 is California law that has been in effect since 1986 to promote clean water and keep toxic substances that can cause cancer and birth defects out of consumer products. Proposition 65's formal title is "The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986". It is administered by Cal/EPA's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA).
